

2009-2010 Round Robin Directions

1. There will be two groups of participants: Monday and Thursday
2. Each participant will be assigned a unique number which will identify the participant and their starting block throughout the project. Ownership of the progressing quilt top and all who work on each round will be blind.
3. Exchange of quilt tops will be done blind, with each project enclosed in a pillowcase, marked only with the symbols of the owner and maker of each round. Participants will make sure not to take their own project or one that they have already worked on.
4. Project coordinators will maintain a master list of each participant's name and identifying number. The coordinators will keep track of which project is currently in the hands of each participant.
5. When the center block is done, bring it to a meeting **NO LATER than October 12 (Monday) or October 15 (Thursday)** and give it to any of the project coordinators listed above.

The first round is due the week of October 12.

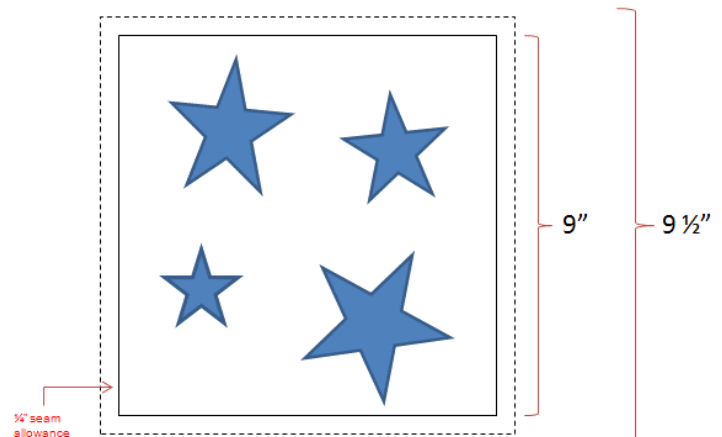
CENTER BLOCK (ON-POINT)

Finished size: 9" square (9 ½" w/ quarter inch seam allowance)

Theme: Any pieced, appliquéd or printed block which portrays your interpretation of a star or stars. This means your fabric may be a star print. You could appliqué star flowers. You could have a pieced star block. You could appliqué a big coffee mug on your center because you just love Starbucks! It's your quilt - you decide!

Note: In the finished quilt, the center block is **ON-POINT**. So if your center block is directional, it should be turned on-point.

Due Date: 10/12 (M) 10/15 (Th)

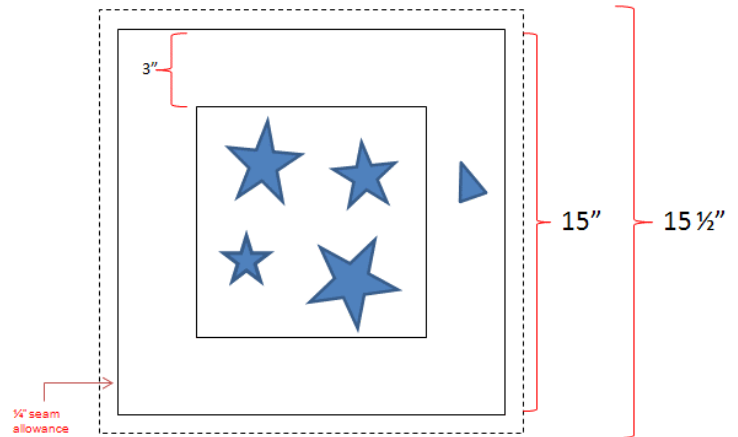


ROUND ONE:

Finished size: 15" square (15 ½" w/ quarter inch seam allowance)

Theme: Three inch border in which you portray your interpretation of triangles and blending / expanding the inner square.

Due Date: 11/9 (M) 11/12 (Th)

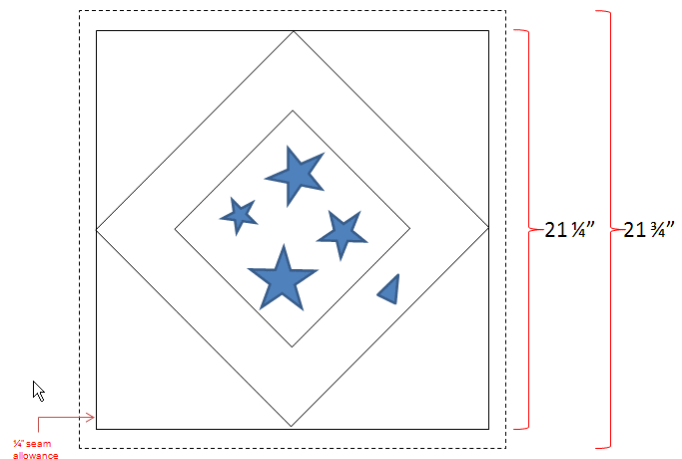


ROUND TWO

Finished size: 21 ¼" square (21 ¾" w/ quarter inch seam allowance)

Theme: Turn on-point and embellish corners (e.g., add appliqué, embroidery, beads, etc.) so that you blend / expand the inner square.

Due Date: 01/11 (M) 01/14 (Th)

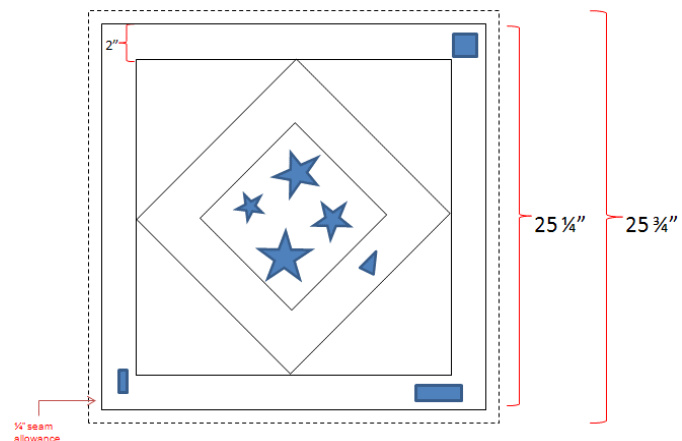


ROUND THREE:

Finished size: 25 ¼" square (25 ¾" w/ quarter inch seam allowance)

Theme: Two inch border in which you portray your interpretation of rectangles and/or squares and blending / expanding the inner square.

Due Date: 02/08 (M) 02/11 (Th)

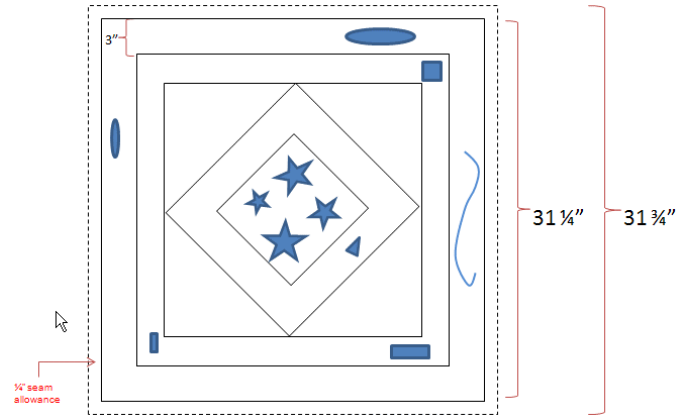


ROUND FOUR:

Finished size: 31 $\frac{1}{4}$ " square (31 $\frac{3}{4}$ " w/
quarter inch seam allowance)

Theme: Three inch border in which you
portray your interpretation of circles
and/or curves and blending / expanding the
inner square.

Due Date: 03/08 (M) 03/11 (Th)



ROUND FIVE:

Finished size: depends on you!

Theme: Add a final border - any size, any
style -- which will tie the piece together
and blends / expands the inner square.
Border can be plain, pieced, or embellished
(with appliqué, embroidery, beads, etc.). It
can be wide, narrow, on-point, or any
combination.

Due Date: 05/10 (M) 05/13 (Th)
