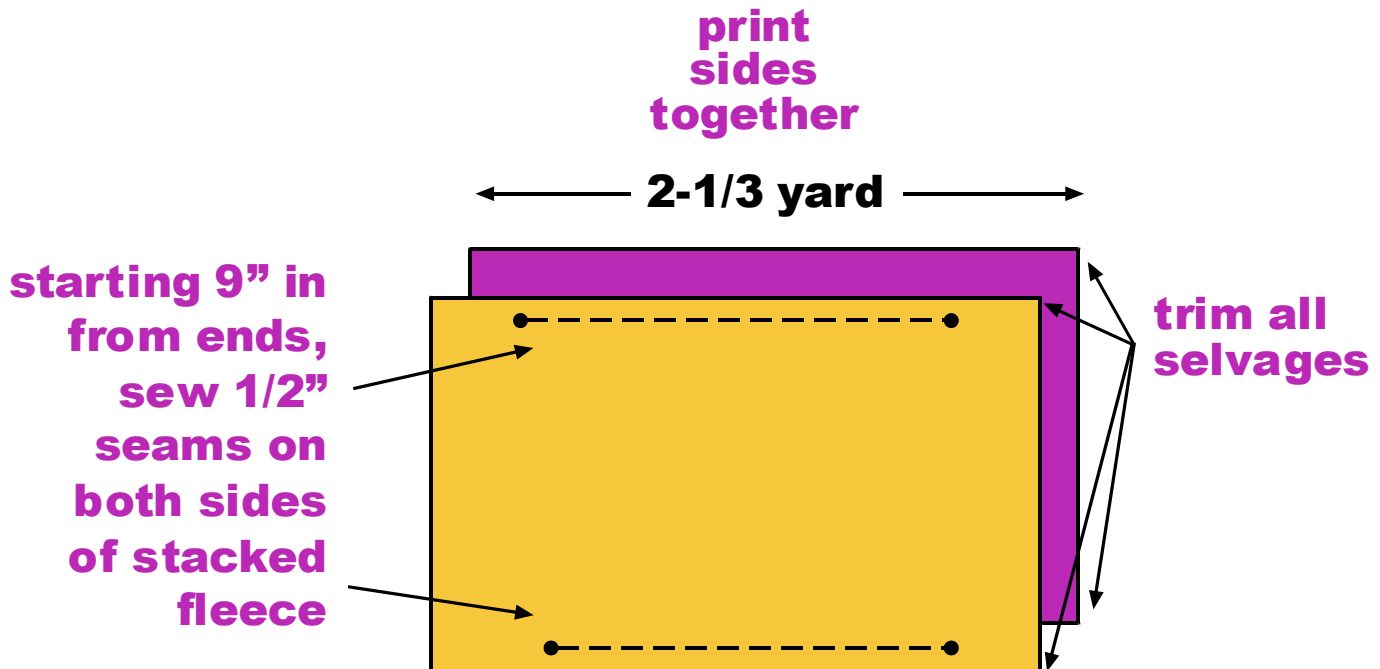


30 Minute Fleece Blanket



1. Purchase:

2-1/3 yards of fleece for top

2-1/3 yards for back

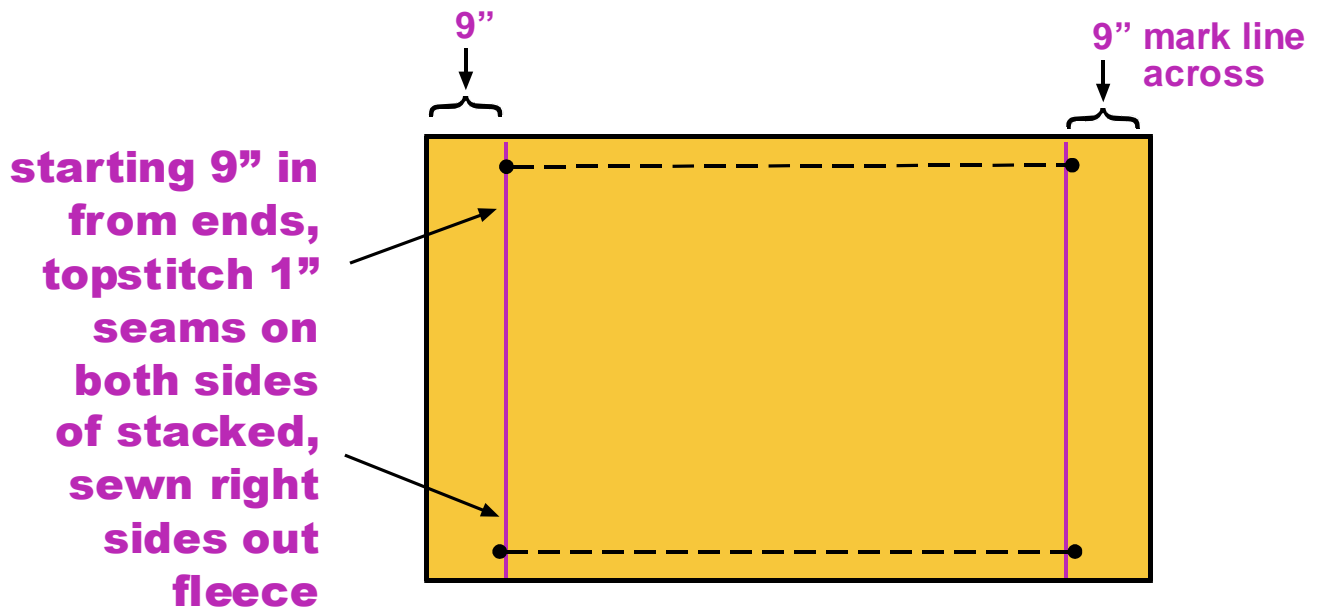
2. Lay right sides of fleece pieces together and stack. **Trim** off curled and printed selvages.

3. **Square up** the 2-1/3 double layer of fleece.

4. **Pin** long sides every 12-16 inches.

5. Starting 9" in from ends of ends of stacked fleece, sew seam on both sides.

6. Turn blanket right side out.



7. **Square ends** if they have shifted.

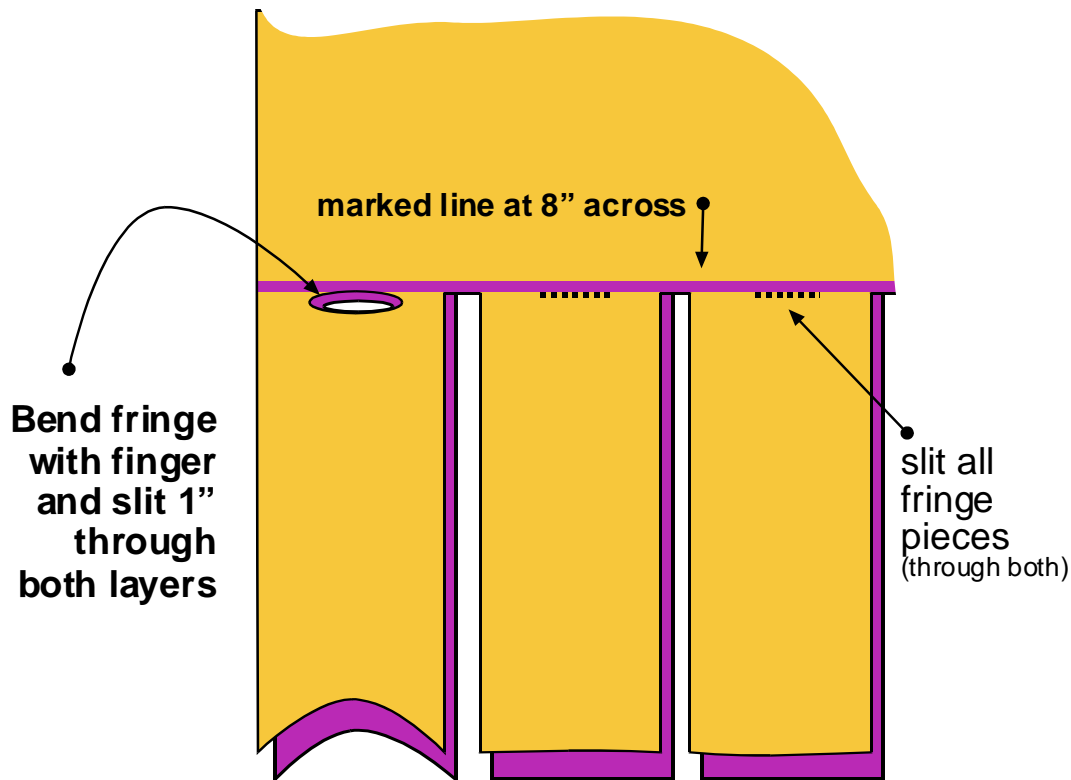
8. **Measure 8" from one end** of blanket and **mark with marker across whole end**. Do the same on the other end.

9. **Top stitch edges 1" in from sides** starting 9" in from both ends - and stopping 9" from both ends. .

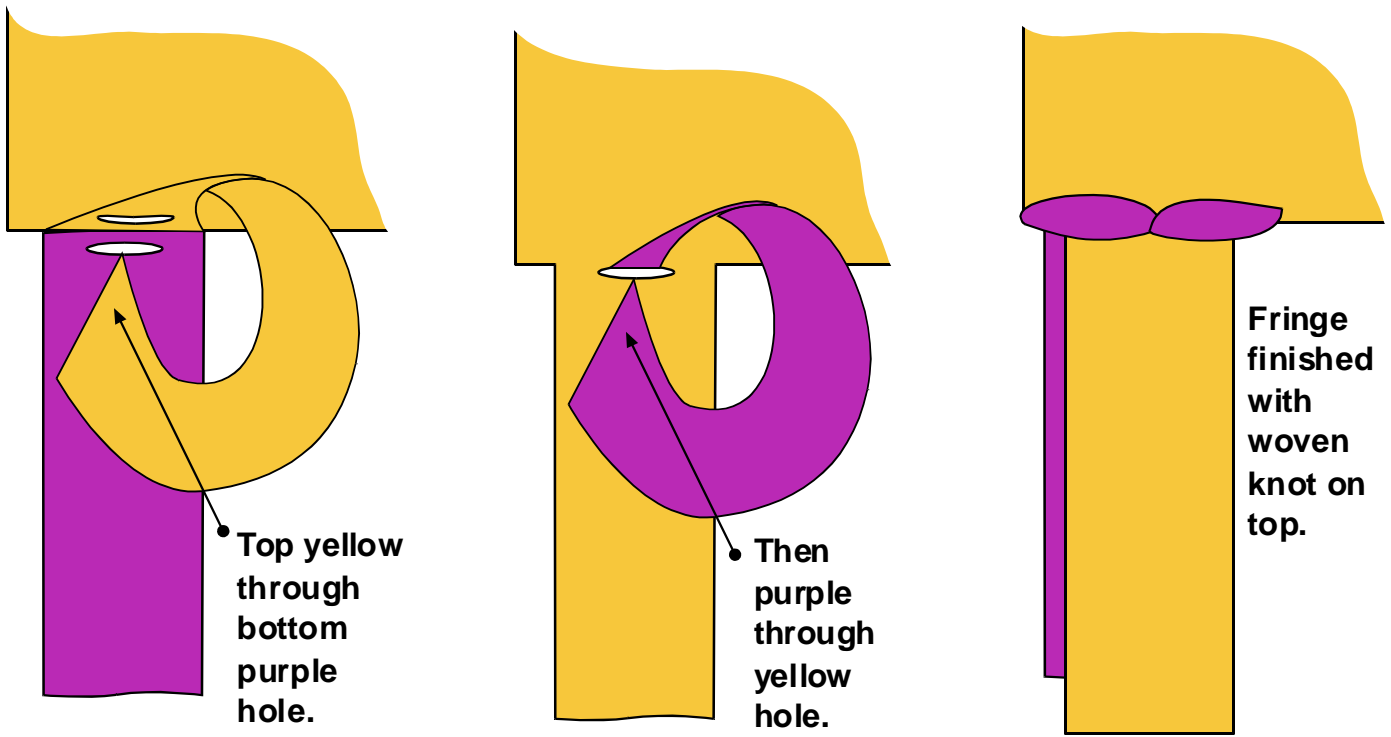
10. **Cut 2-1/2" slits through both layers** across whole end. (You can just eye the 2-1/2 inches)

From here on out the directions will refer to the backing fleece as "yellow", and the top fleece as "purple".

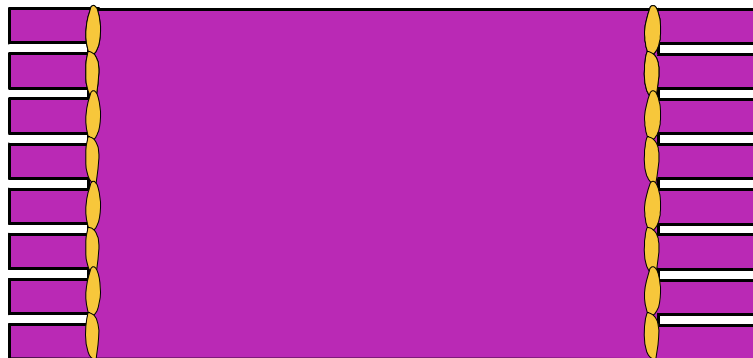
11. **Make double hole in each 2-1/2" fringe piece.** Slip your finger below the stacked fringe stacked piece to make fringe piece bend into an arch. Snip a hole through both layers of fringe - approximately 1" snip. Don't cut your fingers! Bottom snip of purple fleece will be a tad smaller - that is fine.



12. **Double braid each fringe piece.** Take the top yellow piece of fleece and push the corner of fleece through the bottom hole of purple fringe. Pull flat. Now your bottom purple fleece is on the top. Repeat the weave but this time with the top purple piece of fleece. Put purple fringe through the slit hole from the yellow. Pull flat. Finish all fringed edges and you are done!
